- For products the UK manufactures' we will carry out an environmental product life cycle assessment, within the design process, looking for ways to lessen/improve our environmental impact

- Ensure that recycling activities are carried out in 100% of all areas, through internal audits
- Use a dedicated environmental team has been appointed by management
