As producer's of industrial batteries under the Waste Batteries and Accumulators Regulations 2009, we B. Braun Medical Ltd and B. Braun Avitum UK Ltd produce; Nickel Cadmium, Nickel-metal hydride, Lithium ion and Lead acid batteries. We are obliged to take back free of charge waste industrial batteries supplied to an end user, for treatment and recycling. We are required to do this in any calendar year we place new industrial batteries on the market.

If any of our customers or in certain cases other end users, require us to take back Industrial batteries, they should contact us at the below address. We will agree the necessary arrangements for the return, proper treatment and recycling of the waste industrial batteries.

As a producer of portable batteries under the Waste Batteries and Accumulators Regulations 2009, we B. Braun Medical Ltd produce Lithium ion batteries and are registered on the National Waste Packaging Database as a small producer (under 1 tonne per year). We are required to report this amount for each calendar year we place new portable batteries on the market.

Customers can also return waste batteries for disposal to the address below. Please address these to Goods Inwards at our Technical Services unit in Sheffield, **clearly marked 'Waste Batteries'** and we will dispose of them via our permitted waste contractors for proper treatment and recycling.
