Can troubleshoot common alarms					
Can safely return the blood to the patient to end therapy, temporarily disconnect the patient or change kit					
Can safely demonstrate unloading of disposables					
Can safely dispose of clinical waste, in keeping with the trust's policy					
Can clean the machine using the appropriate disinfectant and keeping in line with the manufacturer's guidelines
